

CCGS Des Groseillier

The “Des Gros” is a Canadian Coast Guard Type 1200 ice breaker operating primarily in the Gulf of St. Lawrence and eastern arctic. In order to prepare that ship for future SCM implementation a second cooperative project has been undertaken by Avalon Marine together with the Quebec distributor RMH Industries. In order to confirm rule compliance and to make preparations for a comprehensive baseline survey, Avalon completed a detailed compliance assessment while the ship was alongside in Quebec City During April of 2017.



This ship had undergone previous upgrades which included Thordon COMPAC bearings and WQPs and it was confirmed that SCM compliance was already partially achieved.



CCG plan to complete all of the necessary work required for compliance with SCM survey arrangements during the upcoming dry docking in order to complete a base line survey documenting the bearing clearances and insitu inspection arrangements for the tail shafts.
